


DHANAMANJURI UNIVERSITY

Dhanamanjuri University (D.M. University) has come into existence during the current year under "The Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017" which came into force on the 6th of April, 2018 through a notification in Manipur Gazette published by the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Manipur. "The Dhanamanjuri University Bill, 2017" was passed on the floor of Manipur Legislative Assembly on 3rd August, 2017. The University was established under the National Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA).

Dhanamanjuri University is a long cherished dream of our founding fathers and Maharani Dhanamanjuri, the Mother Spirit in the birth of this seat of learning, translated into action. Manipur, an ancient Kingdom, had a composite traditional system of education in the field of warfare, martial arts, games and sports, culture and many other schools of thought training the people in various professional activities in ancient forms. The people have carried down this legacy of quest for knowledge and civilized existence since time immemorial. Ancient works of knowledge in the original scripts of Manipur stand as testimony to the nurturing of the idea of a University in the minds of our forefathers and foremothers. The state has celebrated the tradition of a purely intellectual pursuit which conserves the original ethos of the land and its people while receptive with an open mind to change in course of time.

The University under the national scheme is built up of five constituent colleges, namely, Dhanamanjuri College of Science (D.M. College of Science), Dhanamanjuri College of Arts (D.M. ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR B.COM:

(f) Application forms for admission to B.Com 1st semester will be issued only to candidates securing 45% marks and above at 10+2 level or its equivalent. However, there is 5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/DP/PCP/SP of eminence and daughter of ex-servicemen. Students will be admitted to B.com first semester on the basis of written test to be conducted by the college under Dhanamanjuri University rules. Application form for admission is enclosed with the prospectus itself.

(i) Selection Procedure:

There shall be a written MCQ Examination for 100 marks.

The written examination shall be for two and a half hours and comprising of questions on:

- a) General English 25 marks
- b) Quantitative and numerical ability 25 marks
- c) Critical Reasoning 25 marks
- d) General Awareness (Business & Economic Environment)- 25 marks
- Selection shall be made purely on marks secured in the written examination.
- (ii) How to apply: Prospectus can be obtained from the college office on payment of prescribed fee by cash or by demand draft payable to the Principal, D.M college of Commerce, Imphal.
- (M) Duly completed application forms together with required enclosures are to be submitted on or before the last date of submission notified by the college /university. Incomplete forms and submitted after the last date shall be summarily rejected.
- (v) Reservation Policy as notified by the State Government from time to time shall be strictly followed.
- (M) Annual intake: the total number of seats in B.Com is 300

- (i) Original Marksheets and Amit Card of class XII and X along with a copy duly attested by a Gazzetted officer.
- (ii) Four copies of recently taken passport size photograph.
- (iii) Provisional Certificate of Class X and Class XII.
- (iv) Caste/Tribe certificate issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioner/SDO in case of Schedule Caste/Tribe category.
- (v) A court affidavit in case of handicapped candidate and candidates with study break.
- (vi) National Level Sports Certificate in case of Sports persons.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

SPECIALIZATION:

In the fourth semester, specialization paper will be introduced. Each student shall have to opt for two (2) specialization groups consisting of three (3) papers each. Total specialization papers to be opted being six (6) are spread over equally in the 4th, 5th and 6th semester. The 1st paper for each selected group shall be studied in 4th semester. The 2nd and 3rd papers of that specialization groups shall be studied in the 5th and 6th semesters respectively.

Group (A) Marketing:

- 1. M1 Customer Relationship Management
- 2. M2 Marketing Communication and Advertising
- 3. M3 Retail Marketing
- 4. M4 Rural Marketing

Group (B) Human Resources Management:

- 1. H1 Industrial Relation
- 2. H2 Training and Development
- 3. H3 Business Ethics
- 4. H4 Social Security and Labour Welfare

Group (C) Banking and Finance:

- 1. F1 Banking and Insurance
- 2. F2 Financial Institutions and Markets
- 3. F3 Management of Financial Services
- 4. F4 Corporate Tax Planning and Tax Management

Note:

- 1. The project report with a weightage of 100 marks shall be written in English on any topic preferably related to any of the two specializations opted and shall be evaluated as per examination rules of the Manipur University.
- 2. The students shall be required to submit four copies of the project report to the principal of the college at least one month before the commencement of the sixth semester examination. The report will carry a weightage of 100 marks and shall be evaluated as per examination rules of the Manipur University.
- 3. The Viva-Voce in the sixth semester shall have a weightage of 100 marks and shall be conducted as per examination rules of Manipur University.

DISSERTATION:

The fifth semester students shall have to submit a dissertation in quadruplicate to the Principal of the college at least one month before the commencement of the fifth semester examination.

117BBA CLASS ATTENDANCE:

- As a step to ensure regularity of the students, those students who fail to secure 75% attendance in the first 2 months of every semester, will not be allowed to appear the University Examination of the semester concerned. Relaxation will be given only under exceptional circumstances.
- ii) Students with poor attendance shall have to pay a fine of Rs.1500/- per subject or as decided by the College Committee.
- iii) No BBA student shall be allowed to join simultaneously any other course whatsoever. In case it is done by any student and it comes to the notice to the college, his/her admission to the course will be cancelled.

BBA EXAMINATION RULES:

- i) The examination for each semester will consist of internal assessment (20 marks) and written examination (80 marks) in each paper if not specified otherwise for any specified paper. The internal assessment marks shall be based on factors such as:
 - a) Participation in seminars, case discussions and group work activities.
 - b) Class tests, quiz, individual and group oral presentation, submission of written assignment, term paper and viva-voce.
 - c) Class room participation and attendance.

 The weightage given to each of these factors shall be decided and announced at the beginning of the semester by individual faculty members responsible for the paper.
- ii) The written examination of 3 hours duration carrying weightage of 80 marks shall be conducted for each paper at the end of each semester.
- iii) The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examination in each semester shall be
 - a) 40% in each paper, project report and comprehensive Viva Voce.
 - b) 45% on the aggregate of each semester examination.
- iv) a) The minimum pass marks for each written paper as well as internal assessment examination shall be 30 marks out of 80 marks and 10 marks out of 20 marks respectively.
 - b) No student shall be permitted to appear at the written examination unless he/she has secured at least 10 marks out of 20 marks in internal assessment in each paper during the semester in question. Such candidates who fail to appear or fail in the internal assessment test may be given a chance by the Principal of the college subject to the submission of application by them to this effect.
- v) If a candidate fails in any semester examination other than the first semester, he/she has to seek for re-admission in the corresponding semester next year; he/she has to apply afresh for pursuing the course.
- vi) A candidate who clears successfully with 40% marks in each paper and 45% marks in aggregate in not less than 60% out of the total papers offered during the semester in question will be provisionally permitted to attend the next semester subject to payment of all fees and dues etc. at their own risk.

- vii) Such candidates shall appear in the remaining paper(s) to fulfill the Clause 5(c) (i) and (ii) above along with the candidates appearing in those papers in the semester next year with payment of examination fee and filling up of the form for the semester and examination in question.
- viii) A special examination shall be arranged for such candidates who have to clear the backlog of the papers at the end of the fifth and sixth semester on receiving application for such examinations but for each such examination separate examination fee has to be paid along with the submission of separate application form. The amount of fee for all such special examination shall be notified by the Principal of the college calculating on actual estimated cost divided by the number of such student in consultation with the Controller of Examination of the University.
- ix) A candidate who having passed the second semester examination discontinues his studies may be allowed to join in the third semester within two years of his passing the second semester examination subject to the payment of all fees to be paid at the time of his admission.
- x) A candidate must pass all the six semester examinations within five years of his/her admission to the first semester of the BBA course.
- xi) The result after the sixth semester examination shall be finalized as under in two classes on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semester examinations taken together subject to the fulfillment of the requirement under clause 5(c).
 - a) Second Class 45% or more marks but less than 60% marks in aggregate
 - b) First Class 60% or more marks in aggregate.

Candidate who passes all the six semester examinations in first attempt securing 75% or more marks of the total aggregate shall be declared to have passed in first class with DISTINCTION.

PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING:

- i) There shall be at least one parent's teachers meeting in every academic session and also to be organized as and when need arises.
- ii) An Induction Programme is organized every year as a move to welcome the newly admitted BBA 1st Semester Students. Parents are also invited for the programme. Such meeting provides a platform for parents and teachers to discuss on issues concerning attendance, progress and future prospects of the students.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR BBA

Eligibility: 10+2 passed students of Council of Higher Secondary Education Manipur or any Indian or Foreign Council recognized by competent authority shall be eligible to apply for admission to this course provided he/she has secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate. Candidates from ST/SC are eligible for a concession of 5% of the aggregate marks.

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA) COURSE

- (i) The degree offered by the Dhanamanjuri University on successful completion of this course shall be known as Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA).
- (ii) The duration of the degree course in Bachelor of Business administration shall be 3 years spread over 6 semesters.

SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR BBA:

- i) All the eligible candidates will be called by the college at their own expenses at the college on the dates notified.
- ii) The entrance test shall be of two and half hours comprising question on
 - a) Language comprehension
 - b) Mathematical skill
 - c) Data Analysis and Numerical Ability
 - d) Quantitative and numerical ability
 - e) Intelligence and Critical Reasoning
 - f) Indian and Global Environment
- iii) a) Out of applicants qualifying in the entrance test, candidates equal to four times of the number of seats will be placed as short-listed, strictly on the basis of merit, shall be called for group discussion and personal interview at their own expenses.
 - b) Group discussion and Personal interview shall be conducted by a team of external experts with individual evaluation by each expert member of such a team.
 - c) Average of such evaluation shall be calculated to find out the score of each candidate at group discussion and personal interview separately.
- iv) The merit list for selection of the relevant categories would be on the basis of marks secured on the aggregate of the following:-

Note: Unless a candidate secures 50% marks in English in the Entrance Test no other paper will be evaluated.

- v) Annual Intake: the total number of seats in BBA course is 50.
- vi) a) Reservation Policy as notified by the State Government from time to time shall be strictly followed.
 - b) All candidates desirous of seeking admission to BBA course must satisfy the eligibility criteria as mentioned vide 3(a) and shall have to appear at the entrance test, group discussion and interview conducted for the purpose of admission.
 - c) Admission of the course will be strictly in line with rules and regulations framed from time to time by Dhanamanjuri University. In all cases, the decision of the college shall be final.
