BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B Com.)

A. Selection Procedure :

There shall be a written MCQ Examination for 50 questions each carrying 2 marks each. The written examination shall be of one hours and comprising of questions on:

- a) General English – 10 questions
- b) Quantitative and numerical ability – 15 questions
- c) Critical Reasoning – 10 questions
- d) General Awareness (Business & Economic Environment) - 15 questions.

Selection shall be made purely on marks secured in the written examination.

B BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA)

There shall be a written MCQ Examination for 50 questions each carrying 2 marks each. The written examination shall be of one hours and comprising of questions on:

- i) All the eligible candidates will be called by the college at their own expenses at the college on the dates notified.
 - a) Language comprehension – 15 questions
 - b) Numerical Ability – 15 questions
 - c) Intelligence and Critical Reasoning – 10 questions
 - d) General Awareness – 10 questions
- ii) Group discussion and Personal interview shall be conducted by a team of external experts with individual evaluation by each expert member of such a team.
- iii) Average of such evaluation shall be calculated to find out the score of each candidate at group discussion and personal interview separately.
- iv) The merit list for selection of the relevant categories would be on the basis of marks secured on the aggregate of the following:-

b)	Group discussion	-	15
c)	Interview	-	15

Note : Unless a candidate secures 50% marks in English in the Entrance Test no other paper will be evaluated.
